## BR: The Winter of Life (Joe Greer) 2020

If you have not yet seen the book, "The Winter of Life – Redeeming the Time," by Sewell Hall, I encourage you to get it. The 160 page book is an easy read that carefully takes you from chapter to chapter exploring the challenges that we all face as age creeps into our lives. The book is divided into thirteen chapters that introduce Bible characters who faced issues as they became older. We can learn and make application for godly living – particularly with issues and decisions that must be made as we get older.

It is not a book just for those 'in the winter of life,' but is helpful to set clear expectations and provide helpful learning to those who are younger, but hope to live to be old one day. The practical teaching of this book resonates loudly with lessons that Christians of every age can use. Brother Hall, in the 90<sup>th</sup> year of his life, writes with the gentleness of character that many of us have learned to depend on from him, and yet very plainly teaches and demonstrates the power of God's word.
